



## Frontier Kids Market Vendor Rules & Regulations

The Frontier Market will be held at the Eaton County Fairgrounds, **rain or shine** (with **no** refunds for rain). In order to make the event enjoyable for the exhibitors and the spectators alike, the following rules will be **strictly enforced**.

### Show Times:

Saturday, September 12, 2026: 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM

### Expectations:

Young entrepreneurs must man their own booths and stay for the entire time. (Kid entrepreneurs are required to be under the age of 18)

### Type of Exhibitors:

- ONLY kids small “businesses” will be allowed to be vendors at the kids market.

### Setup:

Check in is Saturday from 11:00 am – 12:30 pm. Enter the fairgrounds at the rear of the practice field and look for **Registration**.

### Cost:

Outside spaces: One size available

\_\_\_ 12 x12 \$10.00 on or before Aug. 31, 2026.

### Cancellations:

In the event you need to cancel your application, no refunds will be given after Sept. 1, 2026

### Tables & Chairs:

Any tents, tables and chairs needed are to be provided by the vendor.

### Security:

Charlotte Frontier Days (to include all Board Members) will **not** be responsible for vendor’s wares or equipment at any time.

### Housekeeping:

It is **the vendor’s** responsibility to keep the area clean. At the end of the event, the vendor’s area must be clean and litter free.

### Pets:

**Pets are not allowed.** Exception will be given for Service animals. Proof of registered service pet is required.

### Registration for the Festival:

Spaces are filled on a first come, first serve basis.

### Check Out:

At the end of the kids market, the vendor’s area must be clean and litter free. All kid market vendors must be off the grounds by 8:00 pm Saturday, September 12, 2026.

From the North, take I-69 south to the second Charlotte exit (#60), M-50. Turn right or west on M-50/Shepherd Street, turn left (south) on Saint Marys Blvd., Then turn right on third street, follow until end which gets you in the parking lot.

From the South, take I-69 north to the first Charlotte Exit (#60), M-50, and turn left. Turn left (south) on Saint Marys Blvd., then turn right on third street, follow until end which gets you in the parking lot.

### Parking:

**Parking next to a vendor space or in the parking spaces next to Kardel Hall is not permitted.**
